

Roulettes Tavern Quiet Dinner access guide

Getting there:

Roulettes Tavern is on Main North Road, and near Parafield Airport and Bunnings. There is lots of available parking, including disability spaces.



Ordering:

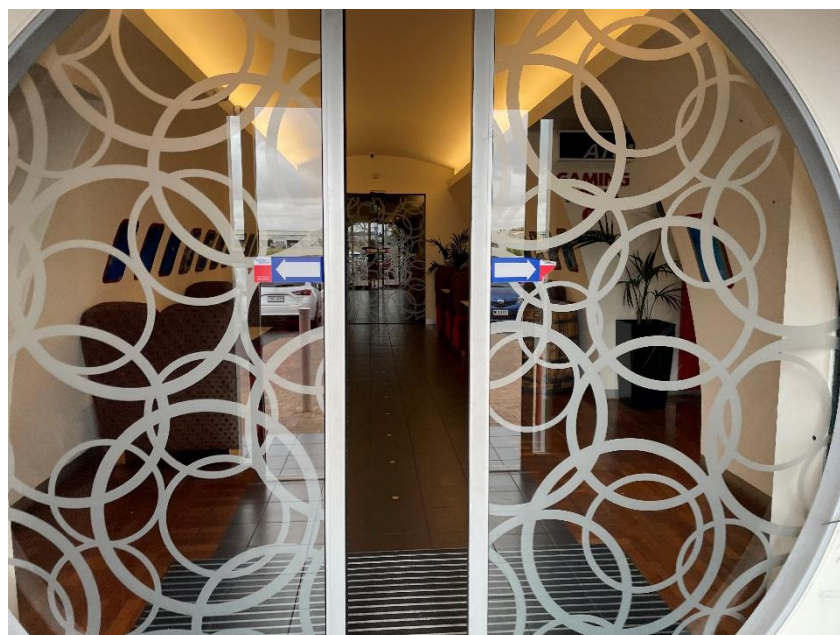
There will be table service on the night, inside the room.

Entrance:

The main entrance is shaped like a red roulette wheel. The entrance is wheelchair accessible.



As you enter, there are automatic doors.



The room inside the entrance looks like the inside of a plane.

There may be music playing in this area. The gaming room is on the side of the room.

There are strips of fluorescent lights which are concealed on the top of the wall.

There are another set of automatic doors into the main bistro area.



Bistro area:

The bistro is a large, open-plan room. There will be a sign letting you know where to go for the Quiet Dinner. There may be music playing in this area. On the left side of the room, there are lots of TVs playing sport.

There are some small fluorescent lights on the ceiling. There are also lamps hanging from the ceiling.

On the left side of the bistro there is lots of natural light from the outside area.



The Quiet Dinner is being held in the function room. You will enter the function room through the hallway.

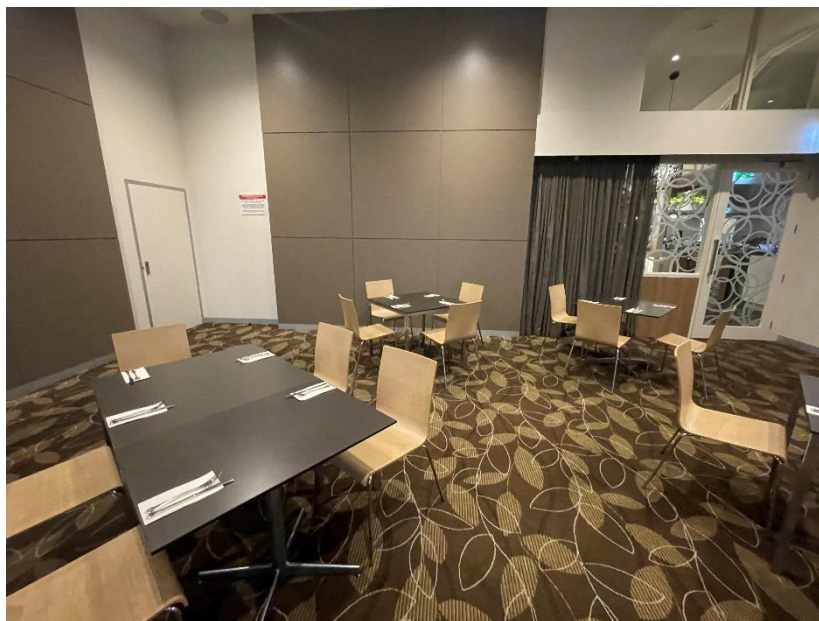


Function room:

The lights will be dimmed, and no music will be played. The TV will be turned off.

There will be a sensory area in the corner, that anyone is welcome to use.

The table setup will be similar to the photo below.



Toilets:

The toilets are located in the hallway. There are male, female and disabled toilets.

There is a separate room in the toilets for hand-washing. There are only hand dryers, no paper towels are available.
